Report Cards

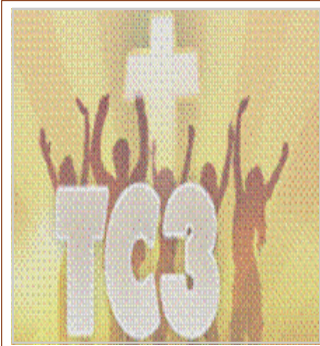
Report Cards for elementary students from grades K-8 will be sent home on Friday, March 13th.
